*For the month of October, you will be required to read a NEW chapter book. Please be sure the book is on your reading level. For your book report, you will be creating a brochure to advertise your book that you read.

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This is what your brochure will look like when you have it unfolded.

***Part A:** For this section, you will give background information about the book. You will write about the **setting and main characters**. Remember, the setting is **WHERE** and **WHEN** the story takes place. You will use lots of color when illustrating your favorite character too.

***Part B:** For this section, you will discuss your **favorite part** of the book. Write 3-5 sentences describing your favorite part of the book using juicy details. You will also write about why this was your favorite part.

***Part C:** For this section, you will be writing about what you learned from your book. All fictional stories have morals. What was this book's lesson? You will also be drawing and coloring a picture of your favorite scene from the book.

***Front:** For the front or cover of your brochure, you will want to include the **title, author** and your **name**. I would suggest using pictures and designs to decorate your cover. Remember, you can use anything to decorate it...glitter, construction paper, glue, stickers, markers, magazine pictures, paint, etc. I would suggest using a ruler to draw straight lines to write on as well.

***Goal:** Your goal is to "sell" the book that you read and get other people to read it. Make your brochure interesting and unique. I want to be excited to read it. Have fun!

***Grade:** You will be graded on completeness, following of directions, neatness, and creativity.

*Special brochure paper will be given out on Thursday, October 26. Book reports will be due TUESDAY, OCTOBER 31.
